

Amazing Swiss

The world of the Swiss Alps is a world of wild beauty. Mountain peaks soar more than 4,000 mts into the sky. Awe inspiring glaciers and gigantic rock formations abound. 7 Nights/8 Days

Zurich – Lucerne – Mount Titlis – Interlaken - Jungfrau – Jungfrauoch – Rhine Falls

Day 1: ARRIVAL AT ZURICH – LUCERNE

On arrival at Zurich Airport transfer to Lucerne by using your Swiss pass. Check into the hotel at Lucerne for an overnight stay.

Day 2: LUCERNE - MOUNT TITLIS WITH ICE FLYER



After breakfast, proceed to Mount Titlis. Head to the Lucerne train station and from there, take a train to Engelberg. Just walk for 10 minutes to reach the starting point of Mt. Titlis. To reach the summit - take a small ski gondola; change into a larger cable car and then into the Titlis 'Rotair' for the trip. The Rotair is a rotating cable car that turns 360 degree for your viewing pleasure. You have to change cable cars twice before reaching the Rotair and it takes roughly 45 minutes to travel from the valley below up to the summit.

Day 3: LUCERNE

Breakfast at Hotel

Rest of the day is at leisure to explore this lovely city, or visit the Swiss Transport Museum, or the IMAX Theatre, or the Lion Monument.

Day 4: LUCERNE – JUNGFRAU

After breakfast, check out of hotel and transfer to Interlaken by using your Swiss Pass.

Day 5: JUNGFRAUJOCH

After breakfast proceed to Jungfrauoch - Europe's highest altitude railway station with 100% snow guaranteed all year round. The trip to Jungfrau takes you via Kleine Scheidegg and through the Eiger North Wall up to the scenic splendours of the Jungfrauoch in the heart of a wonder world of glaciers and eternal ice.

Return to Interlaken in the evening.

Day 6: JUNGFRAU – ZURICH

After breakfast, transfer to Zurich by using your Swiss pass.

Overnight stay in Zurich

Day 7: EXCURSION TO RHINE FALLS

After breakfast proceed to the guided excursion to Rhine Falls. The Journey takes you to Northern Switzerland, a beautiful wine grower's region located close to the German border. You will cross the farming village of Marthalen with its traditional frame houses. Via Schaffhausen (with the well-known Munot Fortress from the 16th century), you will reach the stunning Rhine falls - Europe's biggest waterfall. Get thrilled by this sublime natural phenomenon. Spend an hour at leisure at the falls, before returning to Zurich.

Day 8: END OF TOUR

After breakfast, transfer to airport by using your Swiss Pass.
