DAY 1: Lima

Arrival in Lima Reception and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Lima

DAY 2: Lima

CITY TOUR + LARCO MUSEUM

Visit colonial Lima's downtown: go around the Main Square, where you can find the Presidential Palace, the Cathedral, the Archbishop's Palace and the Metropolitan City Hall, historic and traditional buildings.

Then get to know Santo Domingo church and monastery, a XVII century jewel, recognized as cultural heritage by UNESCO.

The tour goes on to the modern district of San Isidro. Finally you will visit Larco Museum, a private collection that

has a collection of treasures from Old Peru, and allows visitors to discover, understand and enjoy more than five thousand years of ancient Peru's history through more than 45,000 pieces. Overnight in Lima

Arrival in Cusco, meet and transfer to the hotel.

WALKING TOUR

With the tour, walk around and appreciate the colonial city of Cusco, built over the foundations of Incan palaces. We will be able to visit the Koricancha or Temple of the Sun, where you will be able to appreciate the magnificent building work; and the Main Square, where we will visit the Cathedral, with impressive crafts on carved wood. Lastly, visit to the neighbourhood of San Blas where the best artists live.

SACRED VALLEY OF THE INCAS (OLLANTAYTAMBO, PISAC MARKET & LUNCH)

Early in the morning you will travel to Ollantaytambo, an Inca vestige that was a military, religious and agricultural centre. Here the fortress is located in the highest part of the mountain, protected the valley from the invaders. The view of the town from the top is overwhelming, narrow streets and water channels are still used by the locals.

After lunch at a local restaurant, we continue to Pisac, a beautiful town famous for its typical handicraft market, full of colour and tradition.

MACHU PICCHU WITH VISTADOME TRAIN

Awaiting you today is by far one of the high points in world tourism: Machu Picchu. Your adventure starts on a train ride to the city of Aguas Calientes, where you disembark and then board a bus that drives you to the actual Machu Picchu archaeological site. An experience you will never forget. The tour includes every nook and cranny of this Wonder of the World (One of the New 7 Wonders of the world) and UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. Later there is some free time for you to explore the site on your own, to relax or to meditate.



At the agreed upon hour, you will descend to Aguas Calientes for lunch at a local restaurant and later return to your hotel.

PERITO MORENO GLACIER TOUR - FEE INCLUDED

The Perito Moreno Glacier rises majestically 80 km away from El Calafate. This is one of the largest and the only advancing glacier in the world, as well as the biggest attraction at Los Glaciares National Park, a 600,000-hectare protected area covered by an ice mantle. We will start by penetrating the Patagonic Andean forest and make a first breath-taking stop at "Curva de los Suspiros" (Curve of Sighs), where you will enjoy a view of this incredible natural wonder. When we approach the

glacier, we will walk down the wooden catwalks to approach the Glacier and admire from different panoramic points this wonderful creation of Mother Nature.

We will be able to contemplate very closely when varied-sized ice blocks loosen and fall into the water with a great thunder becoming beautiful ice floes in the deep waters of the Lago Argentino. This day will be an unforgettable experience - a once in a lifetime amusement.

CORCOVADO & SUGAR LOAF WITH LUNCH

This is a combination package including the Corcovado and Sugar Loaf Tours, including lunch. After pick-up, tour will take the Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas (lagoon) and reach the Rebouças tunnel, a 2.6 km long complex. This tunnel links the southern and northern parts of the city cut in half by the Tijuca ridge that makes Rio the only city in the world to have a National Park 5 minutes from downtown. Reaching the Cosme Velho district, tour members will take a cogwheel train of Swiss manufacture that climbs the mountain from its base at 15 mts. to almost its summit at 670 mts. The top is reached by climbing a flight of steps reaching the base of Christ the Redeemer statue. This statue covered with a mosaic of soapstone is one of Rio's finest Art Nouveau monuments. The view, from this vantage point, with the surrounding Tijuca National Forest spread below and a circle of



mountains closing the horizon at the very back of the Guanabara Bay. Tour will continue taking another way to return the hotel. Guide will take around 40 minutes to show the city and the statue to passengers. After this return to the train, and descend to Cosme Velho to board the bus to visit São Conrado and Pepino Beach, where the hang gliders soar. Lunch will be served in a local Rio de Janeiro restaurant. In the afternoon, tour will continue visiting downtown Rio, a city that has been the capital of Colonial Brazil, the capital of the Portugal and Brazil Empire and now a Republic. Most of the attractions are highlights of these periods and are part of the Brazilian National Heritage. The Sugar Loaf is known as Rio's postcard and is a must visit. Since the best time of the day to go up the cable car is later in the day tour will close at the Sugar Loaf.

Sugar Loaf is reached on a two-stage cable car ride. This cable car in operation is of Italian manufacture and takes 80 persons per trip on a 2-minute ride. The first stage, Morro da Urca - barely 170 mts. high, has a restaurant, amphitheatre, a helipoint for scenic rides and a privileged view of the Yacht Club and Botafogo Bay. The second stage takes one up to the Sugar Loaf - named because of the loaves of sugar that were commonly used by the Portuguese at the time of the discovery of the city. The all-encompassing view of this 270-meter high lookout is unrivalled. This is the only site where one will have a full view of Copacabana beach.

DAY 13: Rio de Janeiro / Iguassu

Breakfast at the hotel

Transfer from the hotel to the airport. Flight from Rio de Janeiro to Iguassu

Arrival in Rio de Janeiro, meet and transfer to the hotel.

BRAZILIAN SIDE OF THE FALLS

Located on the west end of the Paraná River, the Iguazú Park is a huge tropical rainforest which has been declared a World Heritage Site. It is one of the largest forest reserves in South America. Countless flora and fauna species are found here. We will take an elevator down to the base of the waterfalls and stop right above the river level. From a 1,000-meter footbridge, we will be able to admire the majestic Iguazú Falls or go up an elevator to the Salto Floreano viewpoint.

DAY 14: Iguassu / Sao Paulo

ARGENTINEAN SIDE OF THE FALLS

Iguazú National Park —a total of 55,500 hectares— bears the name of the river serving as northern border, which means 'great waters' in the Guaraní language. Surrounded by a lush subtropical rainforest, we will find the majestic Iguazú Waterfalls. Its water volume and more than 275 falls, places it among the most important and spectacular waterfalls in the world. On different footbridges we will visit the heart of the waterfalls, appreciating them from different angles. We will visit the lower circuit and feel part of nature, refreshing ourselves with waterfall drizzle. On the upper circuit we will

stop at different viewpoints, and then reach the balcony at Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat). No doubt, this is the most amazing of all the falls, water falls down from 80 meters.

Transfer to the airport.
Flight from Iguassu to Sao Paulo
Arrival in Sao Paulo, meet and transfer to the hotel.
Overnight in Sao Paulo
